LITERACY

- Year 1:** Children will be creating a small book about animals in Kenya, focusing on the development of descriptive language.
- Year 2:** Can I punctuate statements, questions, exclamations and commands? Can I recognise the features of instructions?
- Year 3:** Children are focusing on 'talk for write' within our Myth topic. We will be describing the setting and mythical creature.
- Year 4:** Pupils will complete their explanation text.
- Year 5:** Historical Narrative – 20,000 Leagues under the sea. Planning and writing a historical narrative using some, most or all of the features
- Year 6:** Pupils will be learning about how to write play scripts based on a Greek Myth.

MATHS

- Year 1:** We will be working on place value and counting with tens and units.
- Year 2:** Can I solve multiplication and division word problems?
- Year 3:** This week children will be learning about perimeter. Children will become architects and design using perimeter.
- Year 4:** Pupils will be starting the new topic of additive reasoning. They will start with work on addition and subtraction.
- Year 5:** Measurement- Looking at time, volume and capacity.
- Year 6:** Pupils will be learning how to solve problems involving decimal numbers especially when used for money and measurements.
