LITERACY

- Year 1:** Children will find special beans in the classroom and write about where they think they have come from.
- Year 2:** I can comprehend. I can use commas in a list.
- Year 3:** Children will continue to prepare for their poem presentation with performance poetry and Haiku.
- Year 4:** Pupils will be drafting newspaper articles and peer assessing each other's work in order to prepare for their best write next week.
- Year 5:** Narrative poetry – 'The Highwayman'.
- Year 6:** We will continue working on our poems about 'Beowulf', including beginning to perform part of the poem using intonation, volume and gestures. We will also explore relative clauses beginning with who, which, where, when, why or whose.

MATHS

- Year 1:** We will be recapping number bonds to ten and twenty and learning how to add using the 'bridging' method.
- Year 2:** Can I find, name and write fractions of a length, shape set of objects or amount, including $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{4}$, $\frac{1}{2}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$? Can I write simple fractions facts such as $\frac{1}{2}$ of $6 = 3$?
- Year 3:** Children will be learning about pictograms, bar graphs and how to interpret information from these.
- Year 4:** Pupils will be starting their new unit of shapes. Pupils will be revising classifying shapes according to their properties.
- Year 5:** Statistics and graphs.
- Year 6:** We will be completing our work on algebra before assessing the children's learning later in the week.
