LITERACY

- Year 1:** We will be developing our Talk 4 Writing skills, using the book “Whatever Next”.
- Year 2:** Can I create a flow chart?
- Year 3:** Within our poetry topic, children will be learning how to perform poetry by adding expression and actions.
- Year 4:** Pupils will be reviewing the features of a newspaper article, identifying formal language and drafting the main body of text.
- Year 5:** Narrative poetry – ‘The Highwayman’.
- Year 6:** We will be studying the story of ‘Beowulf’ in poem form and exploring the Saxons language and its connection to modern day English. We will also revise word families.

MATHS

- Year 1:** We will be continuing work with number lines, alongside some measurement and fractions assessments.
- Year 2:** Can I find and show numbers using number lines and number squares?
- Year 3:** Children will learn about money and use decimals to show the difference between pounds and pence.
- Year 4:** Pupils will be starting a new unit ‘multiplicative reasoning’. There will be a help sheet with more information, for parents posted on Class Dojo.
- Year 5:** Statistics and graphs.
- Year 6:** We will be solving missing number problems using algebra, finding two unknowns in a sum and finding all possible combinations of two variables in a formula.
