LITERACY



Year 1: We will be retelling the story of The Great Fire of London through drama and role play.

Year 2: The children will continue to write their narratives.

Year 3: This week we will be doing Golden tasks! This is an opportunity for the children to show off and independently demonstrate their writing skills. They will review various units done throughout the year and write about them including all of the features covered, eventually producing a number of texts to be proud of.

Year 4: The children will be reviewing how to integrate prefixes and suffixes into their writing to extend their vocabulary.

Year 5: The students will be finishing their suspense and mystery stories.

Year 6: Pupils will be exploring the difference between formal and informal language. They will also be looking at and writing their own poems on the theme of being a refugee.

MATHS

Year 1: We will be comparing numbers from 1-100, identifying numbers that are greater or less than.

Year 2: This week, the year 2 children will be continuing to revise numerous maths concepts.

Year 3: We will starting our unit on Statistics, looking at the features of charts, bar graphs and pictograms.

Year 4: The students will be reviewing addition and subtraction of fractions, decimals, units of measure and time.

Year 5: The children will be revising problem-solving and reasoning.

Year 6: Over the next 3 weeks, pupils will be reinforcing number skills as well as looking more deeply at algebra, reading scales, scale drawings and statistics.

Transition Day 7th June: We are all excited about Transition Day this Thursday! The children will meet their new teachers, except for those new staff joining us from abroad. Drop-off and pick up procedures will be the same and all children are to wear PE kits (except Year 6, who need to pack theirs please).
