LITERACY

Year 1: Children will be examining features of postcards and talking about their holiday experiences.

Year 2: Can I use the possessive apostrophe? Can I learn and perform a Katie Morag story?

Year 3: This week children will begin their myth story writing. We will read about different myths and retell and act out different myth stories. Children will begin to write descriptions of characters and settings.

Year 4: Pupils will be starting a new topic about explanation texts. They will be using time connectives and exploring examples of explanation texts.

Year 5: Historical Narrative – ‘20,000 Leagues Under the Sea’.

Year 6: Pupils will be learning to retell Greek myths by using actions and storyboards and then developing their writing by blending events, dialogue and description.

MATHS

Year 1: Children are looking at patterns, learning to write numbers in words and working with 2D and 3D shapes.

Year 2: Can I use column addition and column subtraction?
Can I answer addition and subtraction word problems?

Year 3: This week we will be learning about fractions. Children will learn to count in tenths and recognise tenths of objects and numbers.

Year 4: Pupils are starting a new topic ‘Number Sense’ and partitioning large numbers including decimals.

Year 5: Fractions, decimals and percentages.

Year 6: Add and subtract fractions with different denominators, using equivalent fractions.
Divide proper fractions by whole numbers
Associate a fraction with division to calculate decimal fraction equivalents
Multiply simple pairs of proper fractions, writing the answer in its simplest form
