Reading - [Link](#)

- Read at home for 20-30 minutes every day and **talk about it with someone**. This will improve your spelling, your writing and your comprehension skills more than anything else.

Spelling - [Link](#)

- 12 Personal and 3 standardised Year 6 spelling words must be practised three times a week ready for the weekly test.

- Math activities will be set every week on Mymaths - Revise and test yourself on what you learnt in class.
- Practise filling in a 12x12 times-table grid **each week**. Try to complete it in less than 3 minutes. Can you do this with the all the numbers mixed up?

Autumn Term - Ancient Greece & Electricity

Choose **one** of these activities **each** week and complete it in your homework book. It should take at least an hour to complete the task and must be presented in your best handwriting.

Writing & Speaking - [Link](#)

Every term, each pupil will present to the class.

Part 1: Read the story of Hercules. Make up a suitable 13th task and write it as a story.

Part 2: Learn the story so that you can retell it to a friend in class using the Talk for Writing skills you have learnt this term: e.g. actions for each part. Extension – retell it to the class using actions, expression, changes of pace and gestures. You may work individually or in pairs or groups for this task.

Investigate an Ancient Greek mathematician. Explain his discoveries by drawing diagrams with notes. Extension - Draw some of the nets for the five Platonic Solids.

Use Minecraft or another computer program to make a model of one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. Stick some printouts of your model in your book. Extension – build a modern wonder in your world.

Choose a Greek God or Hero and research all the information you can about them. Describe their appearance, personality, relationships, superpowers and achievements. Extension – create a set of Top Trump cards for Greek Gods/Heroes with a suitable range of scores to be able to play a game.

Create a range of sketches of your Greek god or hero. Draw whole figures in different positions, and close-ups of the face with different expressions. Make sure the proportions of your figures are accurate and use shading to make them more life-like. Extension – create a final art work based on your sketches.
