Dear Parents,

I hope you have all enjoyed a relaxing summer break. I'd like to extend a warm welcome to all our new teachers who have now arrived and are settling into life in Doha. We are also very much looking forward to welcoming all our students back to school next week.

I am delighted to inform you that despite a challenging academic year DBS students in Year 11 and in the 6th Form produced another outstanding set of exam results for the academic year 2020/21. For iGCSE, two main indicators are used to judge examination performance - achieving five grades at 9 - 4 and the number of top end grades achieved. DBS are proud to share that almost half of the cohort (48%) of our students achieved five or more grade 9 - 7, while almost 9/10 (89%) of students achieved five grades 9 - 4. Our IB students achieved 100% pass rate and 92% of our A-Level cohort achieved 3 passes A\*E. We are all immensely proud of the class of 2021 for their achievements.

As per the social media release last week, all schools will resume with a blended learning approach at 50% capacity as per The Ministry of Education and Higher Education (MoEHE) directives. As per last year, students will be split into A & B groups and will attend school on alternate days. Students will access live lessons via Zoom/Google classrooms and class dojo when they are not attending face-toface lessons. I want to reassure parents that the same protocols will be in place for all students who attend school in-person and we will ensure these are adhered to in the strictest possible way. 
## Inside the school


