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LITERACY:



Year 1: This week we will be reading the story 'Rapunzel'. We will be building a tower and using powerful adjectives to describe it. We will be learning about bossy verbs and how we apply these in instructional writing.

Year 2: This week we will plan a setting description.

Year 3: We will be planning our own Fable. The children will be writing a Fable with 2 main animals and the moral of their stories should be: 'Never Trust a Stranger'.

Year 4: This week, children will look at the features of an outsider narrative and create their own examples. Towards the end of the week, they will begin to plan their story. In reading, we will focus on a range of different VIPERS skills.

Year 5: This week the pupils are continuing to learn about the features of a diary entry and will start to plan their own piece of independent writing about Henry's Freedom Box.

Year 6: Children will be analysing the example text and looking for key features of a flashback narrative.

MATHS:

Year 1: This week, we will be exploring fact families for addition and number bonds for numbers within 10.

Year 2: This week we will focus on add and subtract ones as well as find 10 more and 10 less of a number.

Year 3: We will be in our 3rd week of our multiplication and division topic and we will continue to practice the 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6 times table. We will also practice multiplication and division word problems.

Year 4: This week, children will be solving 2-step word problems using the RUCSAC method. They will also learn how to use the inverse method to check their answers.

Year 5: This week we are finishing our learning on multiplication and division.

Year 6: We will be beginning to look at equivalent and simplifying fractions as well as converting them.
