## LITERACY:

**Year 1:** This week we will be finding time connectives, imperative verbs and noun phrases in a text.

**Year 2:** This week we will write questions and responses as well as working on conjunctions.

**Year 3:** This week we will finish writing our fables. Our fables will have 5 paragraphs and by the end of the week we will also edit our stories and aim to make improvements to them.

**Year 4:** This week, children will begin to explore an explanation text linked to our text 'Leaf'. Their main focus will be on the new vocabulary and key phrases, understanding what they mean and using them in context.

**Year 5:** This week the pupils are writing a diary entry from the perspective of one of the main characters.

**Year 6:** Children will be writing their flashback narrative independently.



## MATHS:

**Year 1:** This week, we will be adding numbers together by 'counting on' - 'Lock it! Count on!'

**Year 2:** This week we will focus on Focus Subtraction. Subtract 1 digit from 1 digit. Subtract 1-digit from 2-digits. Subtract 2 two digits.

**Year 3:** We are focusing on the 8 times tables, multiplying by 8 and dividing into equal groups.

**Year 4:** This week, children will begin their new topic of 'Length and Perimeter' and will look at different units of measurement (mm, cm, m and km).

**Year 5:** This week we are learning about finding the area of the shape.

**Year 6:** Children will be comparing and ordering fractions.

**Year 1:** will continue to learn about numbers and colours through a song.

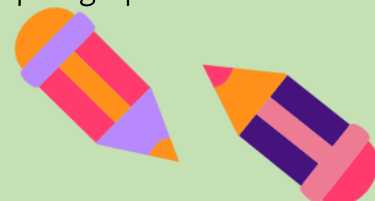
**Year 2:** will continue to practise the Spanish alphabet and use it to spell familiar words.
