Year 1: This week we will be introduced to our new text 'Hermelin'.

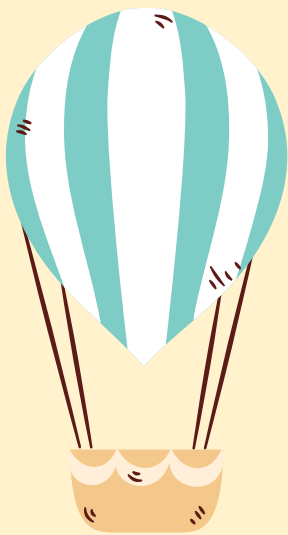
Year 2: This week we will start a new unit. (Finding narrative) We are going to write a setting description.

Year 1: This week, we will continue our work on subtraction and look at the fact families we can make.

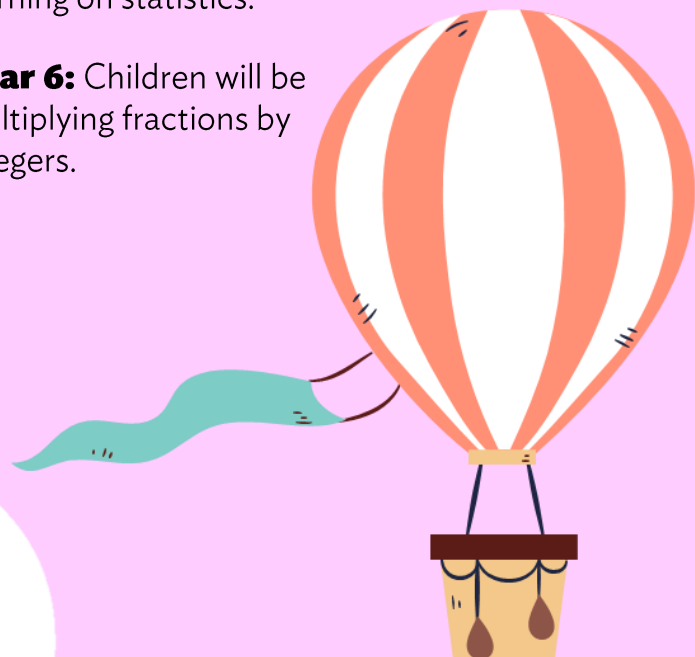
Year 2: This week we will work on number bonds to 100.

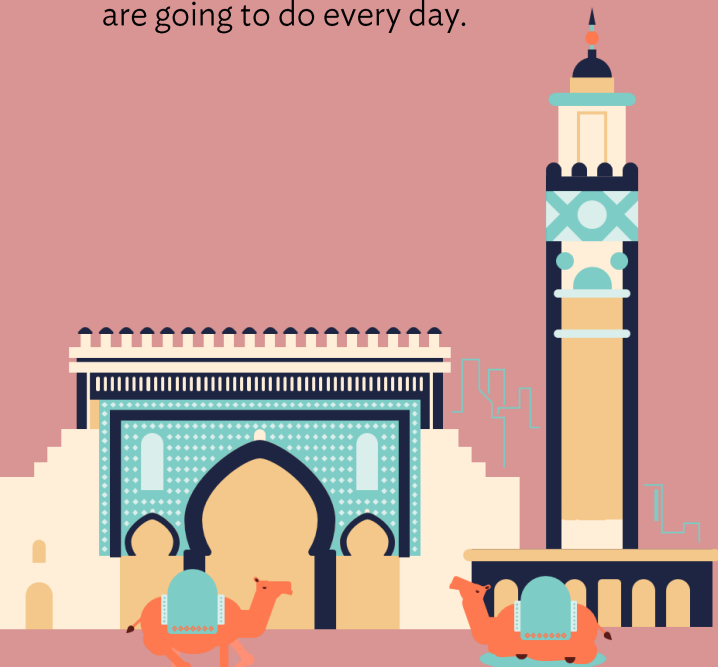

Year 6: will be recapping vocabulary for pets and learn how to describe them.





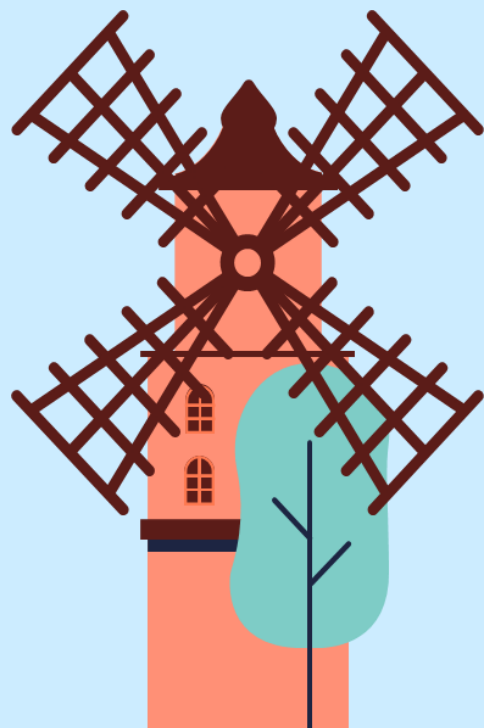
