LITERACY:

Year 1: This week we will be creating a story map and planning our instructions before writing them next week.

Year 2: This week we will look at features and structures of an example text.

Year 3: We will begin planning a non-chronological report about animals. We will focus on using headings, sub-headings, conjunctions and commas.

Year 4: This week, children will be analysing their text and looking for the features of an Explanation Text. They will also use their research skills to find information about Polar Bears.

Year 5: This week the pupils are learning about the features of a biography.

Year 6: Children will be starting a new unit on writing a newspaper report.



MATHS:

Year 1: This week, we will be continuing to work on subtracting numbers within 10.

Year 2: This week we will focus on Focus Subtraction. (Subtracting 2 digit numbers, no exchange.)

Year 3: We will consolidate multiplication and division and we will continue practicing the 2,3,4 and 8 times tables.

Year 4: This week, children will be adding and subtracting different lengths using the column method a They will also be using their conversion skills are converting between different units of measurement.

Year 5: This week we are finishing our learning on area and shape.

Year 6: Children will be adding and subtracting fractions.
