Year 1: This week, we will be writing about finding an old toy.

Year 1: This week we will be counting objects up to 10 and showing numbers in different ways.

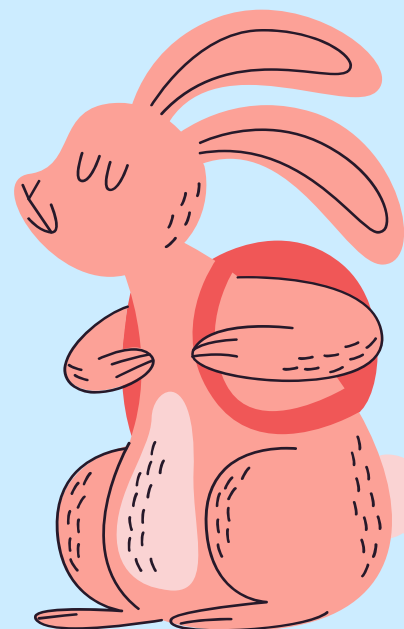
Year 2: This week we will focus on Place Value. (Count and read numbers up to 50).
