Year 4: will learn how to talk about the city and what places we have in Doha.

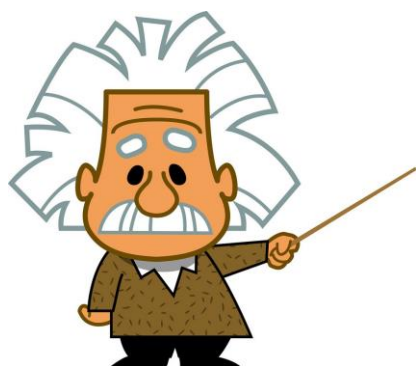
Year 5: will continue with the topic of family and say who is in their family.
