Dear Parents,

As we approach the Holy Month of Ramadan (around 12th/13th April 2021), I would like to set out the plans for the entry and exit of children for the Primary School. To ensure we are following COVID-19 protocols, drop-off and pick-up zones will remain the same with an adjustment to the timings. We will continue to operate a 6-period timetable and children will attend school as per the normal blended model. Next term will begin with Group B attending on Sunday 11th April.

LITERACY:

Year 1: We will be learning about The Great Fire of London.

Year 2: This week we will start with our Non Fiction unit. We are going to introduce the example text and focus on the new vocabulary. Comprehension questions based on example text.

Year 3: In writing we will be starting a new text which children will find out during their reveal lesson. We will then be looking at the new vocabulary from the story.

In reading we will be starting our new story 'Tilly and the Time Machine'. This week we will be focussing on the Vocabulary Viper.

Year 4: This week children will be editing their narrative.

Year 5: This week children will be editing their narrative.

Year 6: Children will be introduced to their new vehicle text and will complete a 'cold task' in their writing.

In reading children will be introduced to a new text and answer comprehension questions based on the book.

MATHS:

Year 1: We will be learning about multiplication through arrays.

Year 2: This week we will be continuing with fractions. (focus finding and recognising a third).

Year 3: This week we will be finishing our fractions unit. Children will be revisiting what they have learnt so far about fractions.

Year 4: We will be rounding decimals.

Year 5: We will be rounding decimals.

Year 6: Pupils will begin to form equations and use the inverse to answer them.
