## LITERACY:

**Year 1:** We will be planning and writing our non-chronological reports.

**Year 2:** In the hot task this week we are going to write our own story without any help. (Where two characters are separated and one returns to where they began.)

**Year 3:** In writing we will be finishing our unit writing a setting narrative'. Children will be using their plan from their illustration to write their own setting narrative.

In reading we will be continuing with 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. This week we will be focussing on the Retrieval Viper and understanding why the author writes in a certain way.

**Year 4:** This week children will planning their narrative and participating in a model write.

**Year 5:** Pupils will self-assess and edit their written work to find strengths and areas for improvements They will finish off their novel 'Journey to Jo'Burg' and review it.

**Year 6:** Pupils will be substituting variables and looking at formula in our Algebra unit.

### **MATHS:**

**Year 1:** We will be counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.

**Year 2:** This week we will be continuing with fractions (focus finding and recognising three quaters).

**Year 3:** This week we will be continuing with our fractions unit. Children will be looking at fractions as amounts.

**Year 4:** We will be reviewing decimals.

**Year 5:** Pupils will be introduced to decimals and begin my booking at hundredths and thousandths.

**Year 6:** Pupils will be substituting variables and looking at formula in our Algebra unit.

**Year 4:** will continue to use opinions to talk about healthy food and describe it.


**Year 5:** will continue learn how to tell the time in Spanish.
