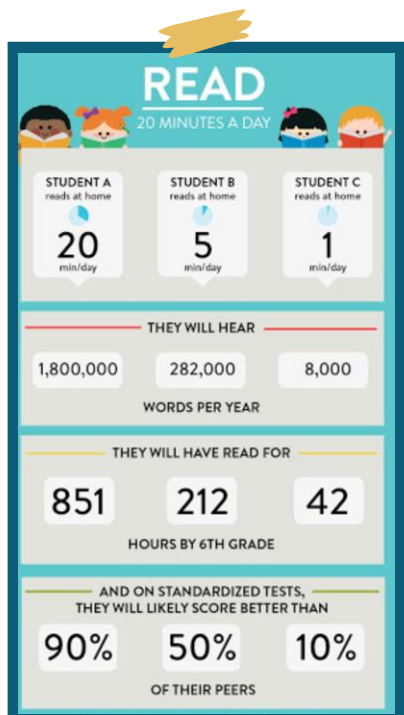
Dear Parents,

LITERACY:

Year 1: We will be learning our story 'Where the Wild Things Are'

Year 2: We are going to start to plan our story.

Year 3: In writing we will be continuing to look at our story 'Rhythm of the rain'. Children will be looking at the different language features and how they can use them in their writing.

In reading we will be continuing with 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory'. This week we will be focussing on the Prediction Viper.

Year 4: This week children will be exploring expanded noun phrases and fronted adverbial sentences.

Year 5: Pupils will continue to explore key features of a character description through our book 'Promises.'

Year 6: We will be analysing the structure and language features of a flashback narrative.

In reading children will begin to read and understand our new text in-depth: War is Over.



MATHS:

Year 1: We will be doing place value with numbers up to 50.

Year 2: This week we will start with fractions. (The focus will be on recognising a half).

Year 3: This week we will be continuing with our fractions unit. Children will be looking at tenths as fractions and decimals.

Year 4: We will begin a new topic of decimals. Children will be looking at the place value of decimal numbers.

Year 5: This week, pupils will adding and subtracting mixed numbers and multiplying a non-unit fraction by an integer.

Year 6: We will continue to work on missing number problems involving percentages.

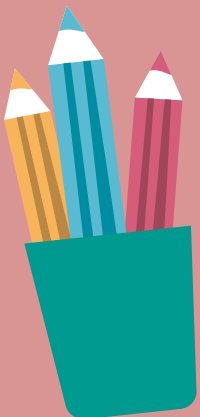
