Two full water bottles in school (we are unable to refill these).



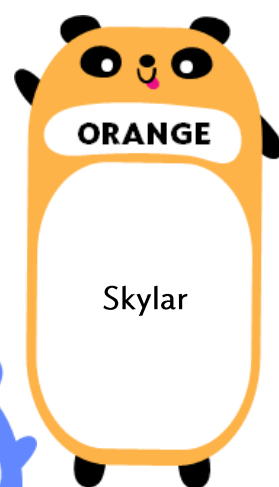
LIBRARY:
