## LIBRARY:

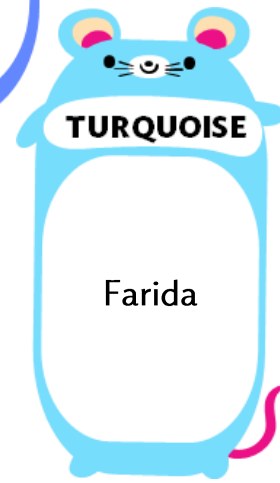
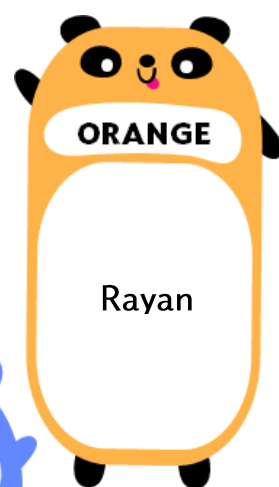
**Library Books** - Unfortunately, children who do not return their books on their library day will not be allowed to take new books out. So please always make sure library books are returned on time.
