

This week has been a great week. We hope you are enjoying online learning with your child!

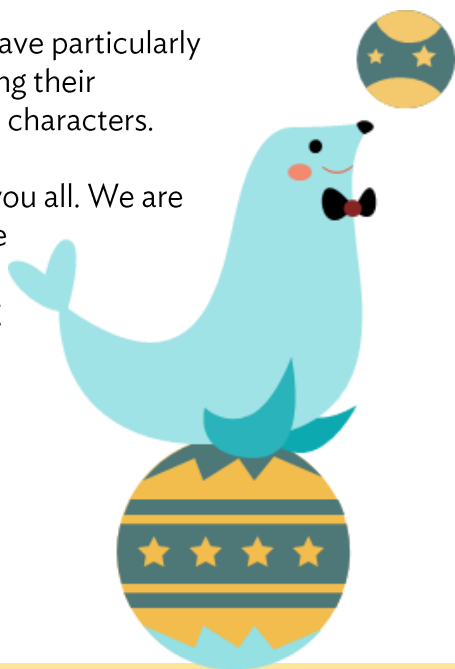

## MESSAGE FROM TEACHERS:
