

This email is for parents of students in Preschool to Year 13.

Dear Parents,

Following the period of 100% online learning, it was announced this week by the Ministry of Education and Higher Education (MoEHE) that schools in Qatar will return to face to face in school learning from Sunday 30th January. The school will revert back to the normal school timings.

As per the MoE announcement:

ALL STUDENTS must take a weekly rapid antigen test at home to allow them to gain entry to the school. The test must be taken within 48 hours before returning to school. (Friday/Saturday).

The results of the weekly rapid antigen test must be brought to school in the form of a declaration document signed by parents as confirmation that the test was carried out on either Friday or Saturday.

The form must be handed in by children in the Primary School to their class teacher and to form tutors in the Secondary School at the start of the day every week on a Sunday.


Instructions regarding the results:
