Dear Parents,

I hope you are all well despite the challenges we are all facing regarding the increase in Covid cases since the turn of the new year.

Since my last communication, as you know DBS have been operating 100% online, can I take this opportunity to thank you all for the manner in which all of our children/students have seamlessly transitioned back to online learning. The levels of engagement and attitude of our students has been excellent. Whilst the MoEHE announcement indicated this period of online learning would last until 27th January, we are still unclear as to whether this timeframe will be extended beyond this date. As and when the MoEHE make an announcement the school will be in contact to all parents.

You may recall me informing you that we had an inspection visit towards the back end of last term. The school was inspected by a team of seven British Schools Overseas (BSO) inspectors who spent 3 full days in the school, observing over 112 lessons across the Primary and Secondary school. The inspection team met with staff at all levels of the organisation, students and parents ascertaining their views, thoughts and opinions on the quality of education provided by the school. This process is part of an accreditation procedure to ensure that as a school, we are meeting the full standards of British Schools Overseas. This process is overseen by Ofsted in the UK.

Finally, Mr Atkinson and the Secondary team are working hard to ensure where possible Year 11 students and students in our Post 16 provision are able to access in school face to face lessons in accordance with the MoEHE guidance, in preparation for their examinations and we hope in the not too distant future we are again able to welcome all of our children/students back to school in a safe and secure learning environment.
