TRICKY WORDS:

Tricky words – Phase 3 – be. Continue to practice any tricky words that your child doesn't know (I, no, go, into, to, the, he, she, we, me). Remember we don't sound these out, we learn them by site!

LITERACY:



Beginning to write captions/sentences.
Talking about capital letters, finger spaces
and full stops.

Children could use their words to write
captions for example – the cat, the mat, the
dog.

When confident, they can develop to write a
sentence for example The big cat. The red
mat, The fat dog.

When writing sentences, it is important
children use their sounds to spell words.

In Reception, we
don't focus on
spelling every word
correctly. We focus
on the children
trying, using their
sounds.
