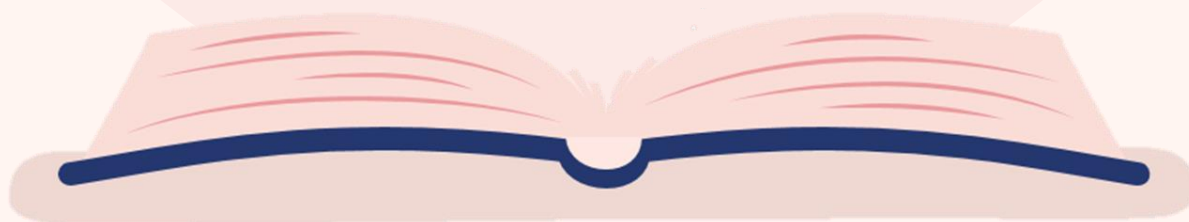
Swimming and Trips

Year 1: This week we will be working on our writer's toolkit, thinking about what features to include in a non-chronological report on a wild thing.

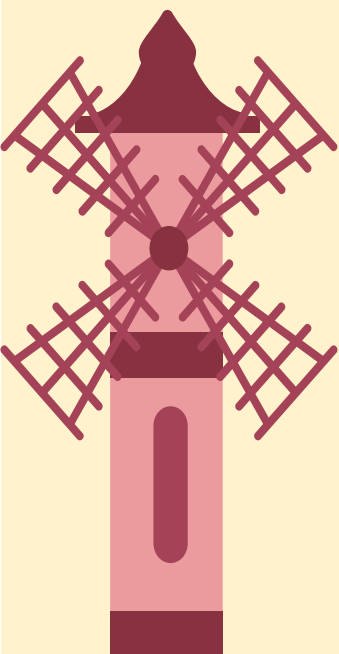
Year 2: We will continue reading 'Rosie Revere engineer' and will make predictions and a diary entry to understand the story.
