Year 1: This week we will be using adjectives to write a setting description.

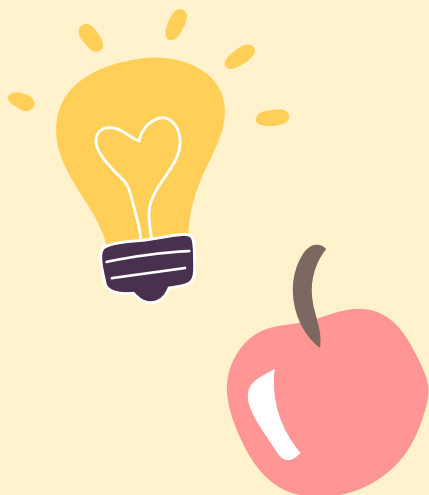
Year 2: This week we are going to write a letter (pretending we are grandpa) and then we will edit it as well.

Year 1: This week, we will be looking at subtracting numbers within 20.

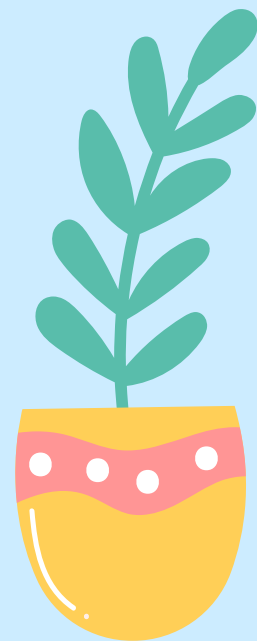
Year 2: This week we will focus on dividing by 10 and odd and even numbers.

Year 1: continue to learn how to present themselves and greet others.

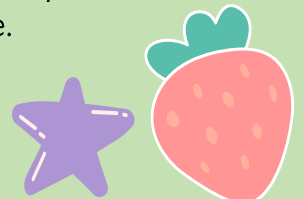
Year 2: will continue to learn about colours.
