LITERACY:

Year 1: This week we will be creating a story map and actions for 'Black Rock'.

Year 2: Children will be mapping their English work and using Talk for Writing.

Year 3: This week, children will be analysing the example text, based on our class story 'Jemmy Button'. They will look at how to sequence events and to add emotion in their letter writing.

Year 4: This week, children will be analysing the example text, based on our class story 'The Lost Happy Endings'. They will look specifically at vocabulary choices and key phrases and how they're used in the text.

Year 5: This week Year 5 students are writing a recount about a journey to space.

Year 6: Children will be exploring spellings, punctuation and grammar within the context of their new unit.



MATHS:

Year 1: This week we will be subtracting numbers within 20.

Year 2: We will be introducing fractions and fractions vocabulary.

Year 3: We will convert measurements and they will calculate the area and perimeter of simple shapes.

Year 4: This week, children will be expanding on their basic knowledge of area by comparing the different areas of shapes. They will also create their own shapes and calculate the area of them.

Year 5: This week we are adding and subtracting fractions.

Year 6: Children will be continuing percentages and working on converting them to fractions.

Year 1: will continue to learn how to present themselves and greet others.

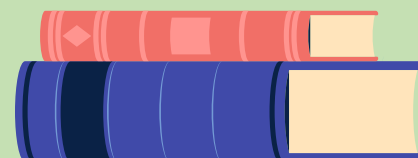
Year 2: will recap numbers.

LIBRARY:

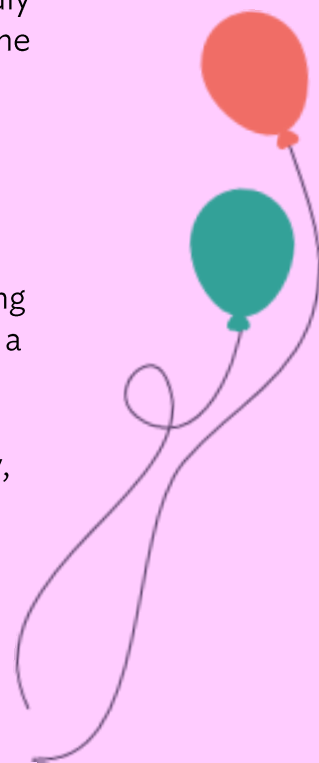
Library Books – Please make sure books are returned in the yellow library folders to allow your child to take a new book out.
