Our topic for the final half term is 'Space'.

Our book of the week has been 'The Dinosaur that pooped a planet' and the children have loved listening to story which is all about a little boy and a dinosaur that travel to the moon. We have done some writing based around this book as well as some art.



SOUNDS OF THE WEEK:

We have now finished Phase 3 so please practice using your sound mat. As well as reading all the words. All phase 3 taught so far – qu, sh, ch, th, ng, ai, oo, oo, ee, igh, oa, oo (look), oo (moon), ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er. Continue to practice any Phase 2 sounds that your child doesn't know as well as all of the phase 3 sounds.

TRICKY WORDS:

Tricky words – All phase 2 and phase 3 – I, no, go, into, to, the, he, she, we, me, be, was, you, they, all, are, my, her. Remember we don't sound these out, we learn them by site!

MESSAGE FROM TEACHERS:

Kidzania school trip next week – Please read the letter carefully and give the consent form/money to the class teacher if you haven't already.

Please could we have any old phones, cameras, laptops, tablets etc that you no longer need – To support children's learning with technology within school. Children to come to school wearing full school uniform, including black shoes. PE kit only on PE days.

Please practice sentence reading and writing at home as much as possible. Remember to provide enough water (the Ministry have taken these facilities away).



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LIBRARY:

To encourage the love for reading, students who are independent readers from Year 2 to Year 6 can change their books during the week if they have already finished reading their book. They can come to the library during their breaks to do so and even can stay if they want a quiet place to read.

Also, a gentle reminder to return the library book for your child to take a new book home.

LITERACY:

Talking about capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Children should be gaining more confidence with writing sentences, they can write sentences about anything at home. About their family/friends, about their favourite story or something they did at the weekend! Anything!
