SOUNDS OF THE WEEK:



We have now finished Phase 3 so please practice using your sound mat. As well as reading all the words. All phase 3 – qu, sh, ch, th, ng, ai, oo, oo, ee, igh, oa, oo (look), oo (moon), ar, or, ur, ow, oi, ear, air, ure, er. Remember to speak to your class teacher to clarify how to say the sounds.

Continue to practice any Phase 2 sounds that your child doesn't know as well as all of the phase 3 sounds.

TRICKY WORDS:

All phase 2 and phase 3 – I, no, go, into, to, the, he, she, we, me, be, was, you, they, all, are, my, her. Remember we don't sound these out, we learn them by site!

MESSAGE FROM TEACHERS:

Children are doing well with coming into the MPH in the mornings; we will also continue this for the final week. Please ensure they are there before 7am to support with their transition.

Class Party – Tuesday 21st June. All children to bring in food to share with the rest of the class (sweet and savoury). They must bring a plate and cutlery too. Snack as normal.

It is very hot so children require short sleeves, sun cream and a sun hat. However, when the weather is very hot/dusty, the children do not go outside. LITERACY:



Writing sentences. Talking about capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

Children should be gaining more confidence with writing sentences, they can write sentences about anything at home. About their family/friends, about their favourite story or something they did at the weekend! Anything!

When writing sentences, it is important children use their sounds to spell words. In Reception, we don't focus on spelling every word correctly. We focus on the children trying, using their sounds.

Halving numbers.

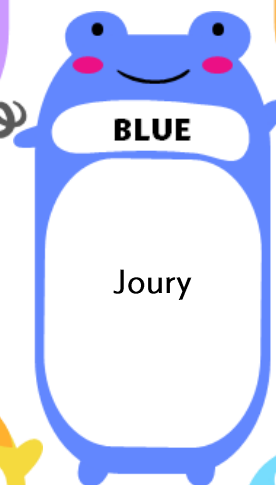


ARABIC:
