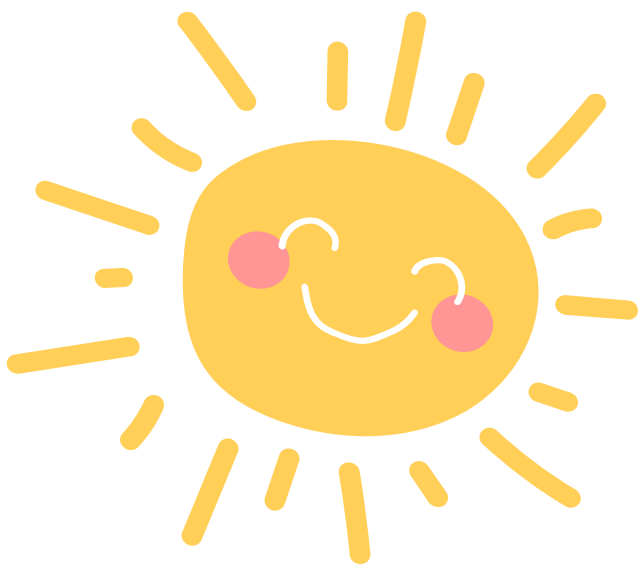


Welcome back we hope you had a lovely a lovely half term!

Sounds of the week – Phase 3 – ch, sh, th, qu. Continue to practice any Phase 2 sounds that your child doesn't know.



Numbers – Number bonds to 10 using a tens frame, part whole model, number line.



TRICKY WORDS:

Phase 3 – they, all. Continue to practice any tricky words that your child doesn't know (I, no, go, into, to, the, he, she, we, me, be, was, you). Remember we don't sound these out, we learn them by site!



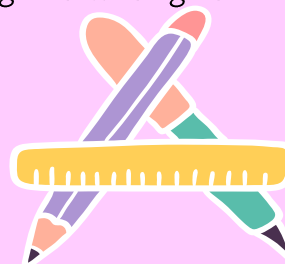
MESSAGE FROM TEACHERS:

Children to come to school wearing full school uniform.

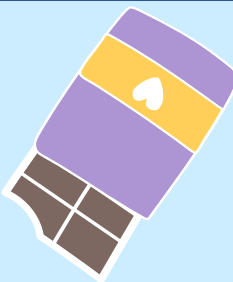
Please practice sentence reading and writing at home as much as possible.

LIBRARY:

Library Books – Please make sure books are returned in the yellow library folders to allow your child to take a new book out.



LITERACY:

Literacy – Writing sentences. Talking about capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.

When confident, they can develop to write a sentence for example The big cat. The red mat, The fat dog.

When writing sentences, it is important children use their sounds to spell words. In Reception, we don't focus on spelling every word correctly. We focus on the children trying, using their sounds.
