LITERACY:

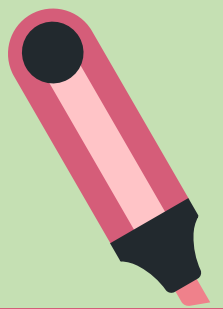
Literacy – Writing sentences. Talking about capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.
