
We are currently embedding Century as our home learning tool. The infographic explains the expectations students are set, which should be completed. This is a way to make sure that topics in school are being revisited, with resources and videos provided by Century, to consolidate the students' learning. Teachers monitor this and are able to gather data including study time taken, questions completed and what they need to be stretched in. The Recommended Path, which is powered by Century's Al system, at the top also brings to the front what Nuggets your child needs to practice or be challenged on, which allows you to also revisit any skills.

Century is a great tool that can be utilised for your child's learning. We hope that the interface is easy to access and please contact class teachers if you need any clarification or help with anything.

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LITERACY:

Year 1: This week, we will be writing sentences using noun phrases and explore our example text: 'Sharp Teeth Sid'.

Year 2: We will be learning how to use conjunctions and contractions in our writing.

Year 3: This week, children will describe the vulnerable creature in their fable narrative using vocabulary from the text.

Year 4: This week, children will be identifying the key features of a diary entry in their example text.

Year 5: This week Year 5 students are writing a setting description about the City of Despair.

Year 6: Children will write a short speech about their dreams for the future.



MATHS:

Year 1: This week, we will be exploring number bonds within 10.

Year 2: This week we will focus on adding tens and ones by bridging to ten.

Year 3: This week children will be adding 3 digit numbers using the column method and exchanging.

Year 4: This week, children will be solving 2-step word problems using the RUCSAC method.

Year 5: This week we are continuing our learning about addition and subtraction.

Year 6: Children will be working on expanded division questions.

Year 1: will draw and write about what is in their pencil case.


Year 2: will identify vowel sounds in stories to help with pronunciation.
