MESSAGE FROM JORDAN DAVIES (HEAD OF PRIMARY)


Important Dates & Events

Dear Parents,

As we come to the end of term (please be reminded that on Tuesday 1st November we will be moving to a reduced timetable and that gates open at 6:50am), I think it is important to reflect on some of our amazing achievements. Swimming began in earnest after 4 years and our children are now swimming more regularly than at any point in the last 7 years; our Kickstart Kilometre initiative has involved over 600 children and parents; we have just finished our Festival of Football; our class assemblies are happening weekly and we had over 100 children and parents attend our desert clean-up with D.E.A.P - normal school life is finally resuming. We also elected our Junior Leadership Team, who immediately set out to make a difference to the lives of the children in our school. Our children are remarkable and continue to amaze me daily. We are still missing our trips and visits and sport competitions but we have been assured by the Ministry of Education that they will begin again in January and are looking forward to enriching our children's lives further.

One final reminder from me, our DBS Carnival is taking place on Saturday from 10am-2pm. I hope to see as many of you there as possible.





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LITERACY:

Year 1: This week, we will be identifying features for reports and planning our reports for 'Sharp Teeth Sid'.

Year 2: We will be consolidating our learning of how to write a diary.

Year 3: This week, children will begin to plan and write their own fable narratives.

Year 4: This week, as a class, children will be planning and writing their own diary entry.

Year 5: This week Year 5 students are writing sentences with direct speech.

Year 6: Children will be writing a contrast poem about human rights and freedom.

MATHS:

Year 1: This week, we will be continuing to practise addition within 10.

Year 2: This week we will consolidate what we have learnt.

Year 3: This week children will be subtracting 3 digit numbers using the formal column method including exchanging.

Year 4: This week, children will be calculating the area in different shapes and comparing them.

Year 5: This week we are beginning our learning on multiplication and division.

Year 6: Children will be working on long division reasoning and problem solving questions.

Year 1: will begin to learn their numbers in Spanish.


Year 2: will be learning the spanish alphabet and identifying different sounds.
