

Year 6: will continue to learn about family.

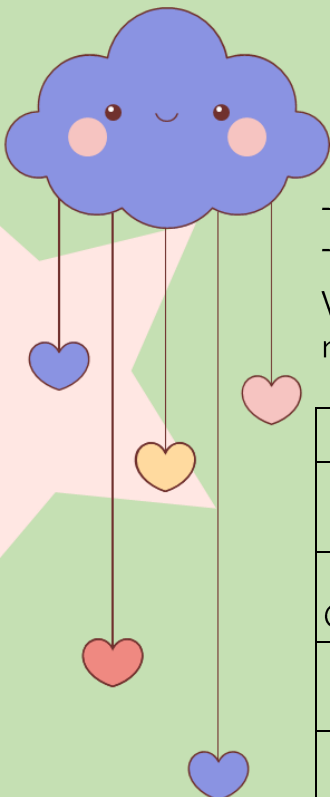
LIBRARY MESSAGE:
