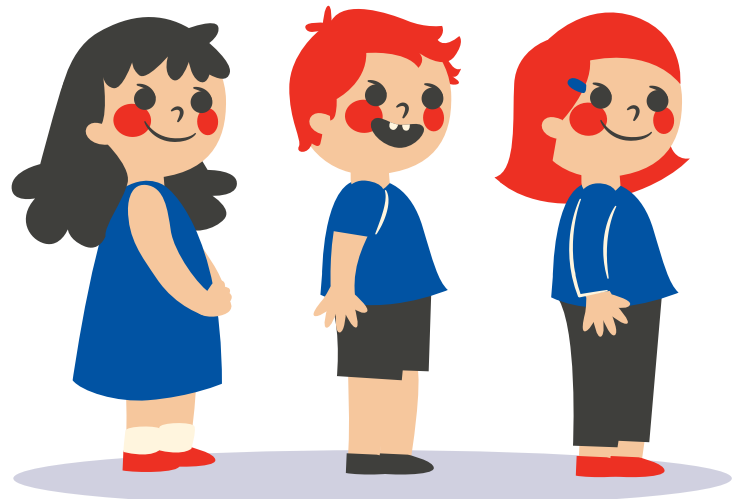
## Home Activities

For safeguarding reasons, parents are not permitted to use the school toilets or assist their children in the school toilets. If you need assistance, please speak to a member of staff.



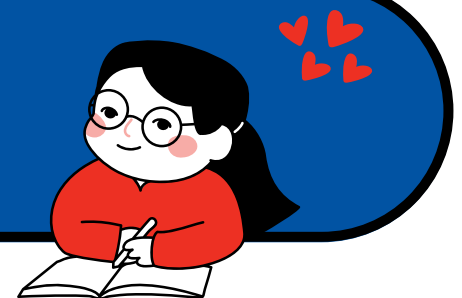
