Synoptic Enquiry: What makes Russia special?

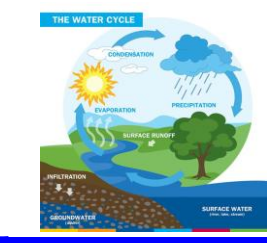
How are our topics brought together in Russia?
