ENGLISH:

EYFS:

Preschool: We will be looking at the book 'Owl Babies' and discussing different emotions. In phonics we will be exploring instrumental sounds

Reception: We will be reading the book 'Owl Babies' and exploring the different emotions. In phonics we will be focusing on the sounds n,m,d,g.

KS1:

Year 1/2: We will be working on our phase 2-5 sounds in phonics and using our knowledge to read and write captions.

KS2:

Year 3/4: We will be developing our knowledge of descriptive vocabulary and how to use it effectively in sentences.

Year 5/6: We will be continuing our work on our writing unit with a focus on character descriptions.



MATHS:

EYFS:

Preschool: We are continuing to explore numbers to 5 and encouraging children to count with 1:1 correspondence (1 number name to each object).

Reception: We will be ordering numbers from 1-10 and continuing to explore patterns.

KS1:

Year 1/2: In Year one we will be sorting, counting and representing numbers to 10. In Year two we will be counting forwards and backwards within 50 and comparing numbers.

KS2:

Year 3/4: We will be continue to develop our knowledge of Place Value. We will be comparing and ordering numbers. We will be using our knowledge to find 10, 100, 1000 more and less.

Year 5/6: We will begin to look at solving problems involving the four operations; adding and subtracting integers, long multiplication and short division.

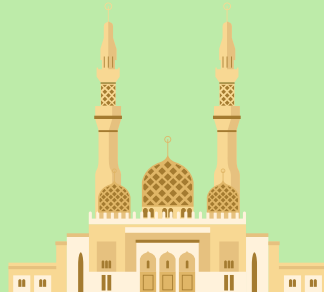
