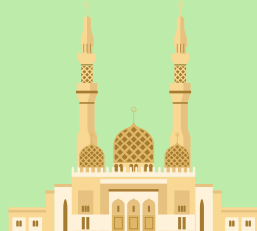

Well done to all of our children who completed races in their P.E lessons this week. We will be doing more fun activities after half-term.

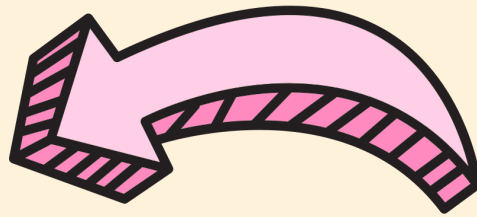
