

World Book Day

World Book Day will be celebrated on Thursday 2nd March 2023



The theme for Secondary pupils this World Book Day follows the message "You Are a Reader," and there will be a focus on reaching children from disadvantaged backgrounds.

We are fortunate to live in Qatar, where disadvantage is not as prevalent as elsewhere in the world. Students across the world are disadvantaged in lots of ways, but we want to focus on the positivity of education and the particular magic that reading can bring to individuals. On world book day we will be asking students and teachers to dress up as a character from a book that they have read who has had to overcome harsh barriers or general adversity in order to succeed.

Examples range from: Katniss Everdeen in The Hunger Games to Pip in Great Expectations, or the Monster in Frankenstein to The Old Man and the Sea and beyond.

Please remind your child to adhere to Qatar's modesty laws and avoid any controversial characters that could offend.

There will be prizes for the best outfit per year group, to be voted on by teachers.
