ENGLISH:

Preschool: We will be reading 'Red Rockets and Rainbow Jelly' as we share our differences and likes/dislikes.

Reception: We will be reading, 'Funny Bones'. We will choose and draw our favourite character in the story and explore the different bones in our bodies.

Year 1: We will be immersing ourselves into 'Where the Wild Things Are'.

Year 2: We will be examining our example text and writing descriptions of our imagined boats.

Year 3: We will continue reading our vehicle text, exploring the thoughts and feelings of the different characters.

Year 4: We will be writing a character description for our main character in our myth narrative.

Year 5: We will be practising the skills needed for writing a character narrative, focusing on modal verbs and direct speech.

Year 6: We will write an action scene for our Battle Narrative.

MATHS:

Preschool: We will be exploring counting songs as we count in sequence and recognise numerals 1-5.

Reception: We will be exploring comparing amounts and comparing size.

Year 1: We will be looking at Place Value from 1-10

Year 2: We will be continuing with Place Value and looking at comparing numbers using more than and less than.

Year 3: We will partition numbers up to 1000.

Year 4: We will be comparing and ordering numbers up to thousands.

Year 5: We will be comparing, ordering and rounding numbers to 1,000,000.
