Preschool: We will be reading 'From Head to Toe' as we learn about our five senses.

Reception: We will be reading, 'Supertato'. We will be creating wanted posters for the Evil Pea and designing our own vegetable superheroes.

Year 5: We will be rounding numbers to the nearest 10,100 and 1000 within 1,000,000.

Year 3: We are using food words to inspire new rhythms.

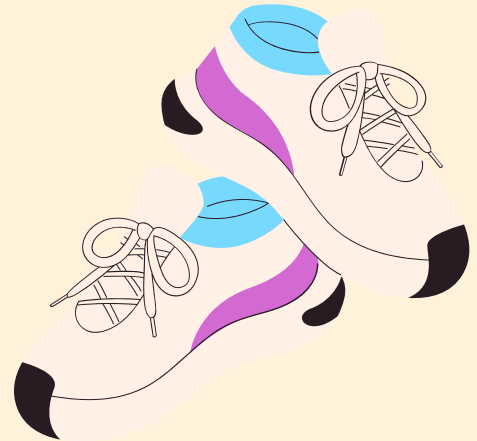
Year 4: We are creating our own Harry Potter themed ostinatos and performing in a group.
