MATHS:

<u>**Preschool:**</u> We will be exploring properties of circles and other 2D shapes.

Reception: We will be recapping and continuing to explore 1 more and 1 less. We will also look at the composition of numbers 1, 2, 3.

Year 1: We will be recaping one more and one less using the number line. We will also look at ordering numbers in three.

Year 2: We are continuing our work on addition and looking at number bonds to 100 in 10s and then 10s and 1s.

Year 3: We will be revisiting place value, looking at number lines and odd and even numbers.

Year 4: We will begin looking at subtracting 4-digit numbers with and without exchanging.

Year 5: We will begin our multiplication and division unit.

Year 6: We will recap long multiplication and introduce division.


