Year 3: We will consolidate our knowledge of rhythmic notation.

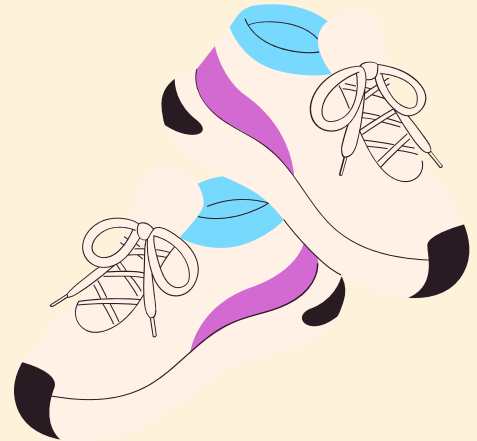
Year 4: We will consolidate our knowledge of rhythmic notation.
