ENGLISH:

Preschool: We will be singing along to 'Old MacDonald Had a Farm' as we mark make and learn about different farm animals.

Reception: We will be reading the traditional tale, 'Jack and the Beanstalk' and will plant seeds and describe the beanstalk using adjectives.

Year 1: We will be analysing our example text and picking out key features and techniques in Instructions.

Year 2: We will begin to Story Map our Example Text about 'The Night Gardener'.

Year 3: We will explore the vocabulary in our vehicle text, "The Fox."

Year 4: We will begin our first multiplication and division unit

Year 4: We will focus on the features of a diary entry before planning our own.

Year 5: We will plan and write a newspaper article linked to our English text.

Year 6: We will begin to summarise and analyse our vehicle text.

MATHS:

<u>Preschool:</u> We will be continuing numeral recognition and introducing 0.

Reception: We will be exploring 3D shapes and identifying 2D shapes within their properties.

Year 1: We will continue learning how to use different methods to help us add. We are also having a look at missing numbers and word problems.

Year 2: We are continuing with Addition and Subtraction focusing on adding 3 one digit numbers.

Year 3: We will be adding and subtracting crossing tens and hundreds.

Year 4: We will begin our first multiplication and division unit and focus on multiplication and division facts.

Year 5: We will be consolidating our multiplication and division knowledge.

Year 6: We will be moving onto our next unit - fractions.

EYFS: We are beginning to play percussion instruments to simple songs.

Year 1: We are playing short sequences on the chime bars using solfege.

Year 2: We are learning about instruments in the brass family.

Year 3: We will combine rhythms on the djembe drums.


Year 4: We will practice B, A and G on the recorder to play a song.



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Please remember all visitors require a lanyard for entry. If you do not have a lanyard, you must submit your QID to security for a visitor's lanyard.




