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ENGLISH:

Preschool: We will be singing along to 'What's the Weather' and making predictions as we engage in science experiments.

<u>Reception:</u> We will be reading the traditional tale, 'Chicken Licken' and will explore rhyme and create our own animal characters to add into the story.

Year 1: We will plan and write our instructions on how to trap a troll.

Year 2: We are examining the different elements of a Diary Entry and beginning to plan our own writing.

Year 3: We will be looking at the key features of our Fox text.

Year 4: We will plan and write our diary entry based on seekng refuge.

Year 5: We will be planning our Biographies and will begin to write a class biography.

Year 6: We will we looking at the key features in our vehicle text.

MATHS:

Preschool: We will be representing 1.

Reception: We will be looking at identifying and subitising the numbers 4 and 5.

Year 1: We will be looking at Number bonds within 10 and number bonds to 10.

Year 2: We are continuing our work on subtraction and addition using two digit numbers, focusing on exchange.

Year 3: We are continuing our work on subtraction using two digit and three digit numbers.

Year 4: We will continue to consolidate our multiplication and division knowledge this week.

Year 5: We will begin our new unit of fractions by looking at unit and non-unit fractions.

Year 6: We will be looking at equivalent fractions and how to simplify them.

Year 3: We will combine rhythms on the djembe drums.


Year 4: We will play songs using B, A and G on the recorder.



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
