#### **ENGLISH:**

**Preschool:** We will be reading and singing along to 'Incy Wincy Spider' as we explore facts about minibeasts.

Year 4: We will begin our new writing unit which will focus on writing a diary entry.

**Year 5:** We will be continuing to immerse ourselves in our text, 'Henry's Freedom Box'.

**Year 6:** We will be exploring the vocabulary used in our vehicle text, 'Dreams of Freedom'.

#### **MATHS:**

<u>**Preschool:**</u> We will be comparing quantities, using words 'more' and 'fewer'.

**Reception:** We will be exploring circles and triangles and their properties. We will also be learning about positional language.

**Year 1:** We will be introducing parts and wholes. We will also be learning about the part whole model and writing number sentences.

**Year 2:** We will be looking at subtraction and taking away ones and tens.

**Year 3:** We will continue our unit on addition and subtraction with 3 digit and 1 digit numbers.

**Year 4:** We will be looking at using the inverse to check our answers

Year 5: We will be learning about square and prime numbers.

**Year 6:** We will be learning to do long division using chunking.

**Year 3:** We will learn new rhythms on the djembe drums.


**Year 4:** We will continue to learn the recorder.
