**Year 1:** We will begin to look at our example text that is based on 'Rapunzel.'

Year 2: We will be reading our new book 'The Night Gardener' and analysing a diary entry.

**Year 3:** We will begin our new writing unit based on the story of The Fox.

**Year 4:** We will plan and write a setting description relating to out English text.

**Year 5:** We will be analysing the features and structure of a Biography.

**Year 6:** We will be using our story Dreams of Freedom to write a speech.

#### **MATHS:**

<u>Preschool:</u> We will be learning about positional language.

**Reception:** We will be learning about 4 sided shapes and exploring how shapes are different.

**Year 1:** We will be learning different methods to help us add such as PPW, using a tens frame and a number line.

**Year 3:** We will learn start to create new rhythms on the djembe drums.


**Year 4:** We will practice B, A and G on the recorder to play a song.
