Adhere to Traffic Safety Laws: It is imperative to closely follow all traffic regulations. <u>**Preschool:**</u> We will be reading 'Little Red Riding Hood' as we continue to create story maps.

**Reception:** We will be exploring the animation, 'Captain Pugwash' as we continue to use our imagination in Drawing club.

Year 1: We will be immersing ourselves into our new text 'Rameena's Ramadan.'

Year 2: We will be starting to immerse ourselves in our new text 'The Bog Baby'.

Year 3: We will continue to immerse ourselves in our core texts for a non-fiction information report

Year 4: We will continue to analyse features of a formal letter.

**Preschool:** We will be consolidating 2D and 3D shapes and focusing on the language used to describe the shapes of everyday objects.

**Year 1:** We are learning rhythmic notation.


**Year 2:** We are adding performing our own music to a story.

**Year 5:** We will be carrying out an investigation to observe the affects of water resistance.


**Year 6:** We will be creating a fact file all about different types of microorganisms.
