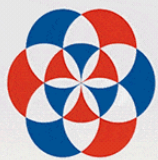

**Year 3:** We are composing our own Chinese music using the pentatonic scale.

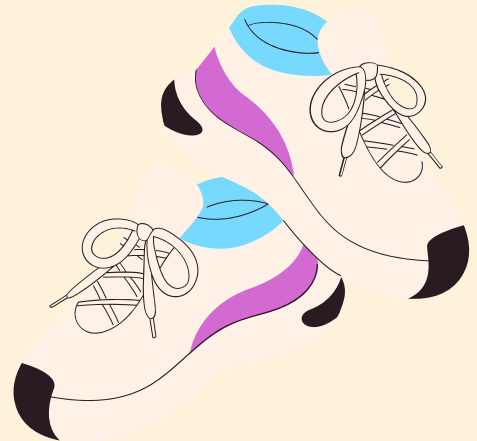
**Year 4:** We are learning about the movement 'Winter' from Vivaldi's 'The Four Seasons'.
