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ENGLISH:

Preschool: We will be reading 'Mad About' Solution Dinosaurs' as we explore facts about dinosaurs and follow a recipe to create salt dough fossils.

Reception: We will be reading, 'There's A Rangtan In My Bedroom' and will design persuasive posters and write short letters related to deforestation.

Year 1: We will begin to look at features of a letter and write a Thank You letter to Hermelin.

Year 2: We will be analysing emotive language, and writing our own poetry.

Year 3: We will continue analysing our example text, looking at the features of a setting description.

Year 4: We will continue analysing our example text, looking at the features of a narrative

Year 5: We will continue to analyse our example text, looking at the features of an exploration narrative and the effect is has on the reader.

Year 6: We will continue reading Shackleton's Journey and begin to look at our example text.

MATHS:

Preschool: We will be comparing and measuring length.

Reception: We will be exploring 1 more and 1 less related to the numbers 6, 7 and 8.

Year 1: We will be starting addition between 0-20.

Year 2: We will be using arrays to have a deeper understanding of multiplication.

Year 3: We will be multiplying and dividing by three and four.

Year 4: We will explore the formal written method and partitioning method for Multiplication

Year 5: We will be consolidating our knowledge on fractions and beginning our multiplication and division unit.

Year 6: We will be exploring measure this week and converting between different measurements.

Year 3: We are singing songs in rounds.


Year 4: We are performing a rock'n'roll dance.
