1. Covered Arms (All Students)

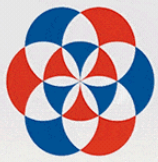

Year 2: We are learning to sing in canon.

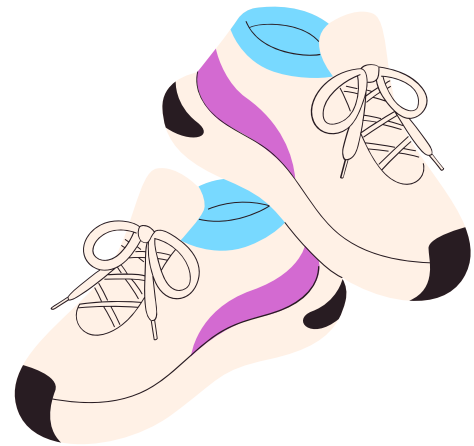
Year 3: We are listening to the final movements of Carnival of the Animals.
