Ramadan kareem. I wish all members of our DBS Wakra community well at this important time of the year.

I would like to remind all parents that all students – with the exception of our EYFS pupils, who leave at 12.30 – leave school each day during Ramadan at 13.00. Because the adults on site must adhere strictly to their Ramadan working hours, we must ensure that all the young people in our care are collected on time. Similarly, school starts each morning at 08.00, and so that no vital learning is lost due to the lateness to lessons, it is essential that all students arrive punctually to school. 100% attendance and 100% punctuality should be the aim of all students at all times of any academic year.

I would also be grateful if all parents could continue to ensure that their children come to school each day in their complete and correct DBS uniform. Our expectation is that students wear their DBS uniforms with pride and that the highest standards are always present. Even now that the hot weather is returning, we can neither allow standards to drop nor allow students to wear items which are not part of our uniform list.
